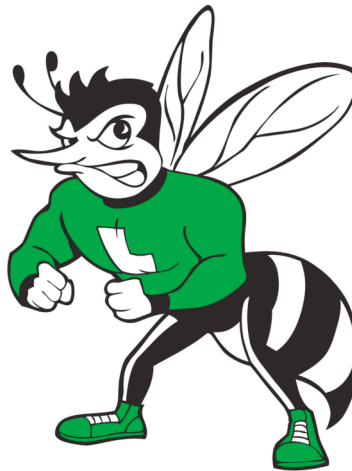

## **Mission Statement**

Our mission is to recognize exceptional students of Lincoln High School for their outstanding service to the campus and community, as well as their academic achievements. As part of the Homecoming tradition, the Lincoln Homecoming Court (Ambassadors) represents, promotes, and advance Hornet Pride through philanthropic endeavors while symbolizing commitment and dedication to Lincoln High School.

The Court Selection Process:

- Students who apply for the court will be interviewed by a panel of staff, students, and community members. They will select the top male and female from each class of applicants, and select the top three males and females from the senior class, with the King and Queen being chosen from the top three seniors.
- The winners will be announced on Tuesday, October 6<sup>th</sup> during lunch in the center quad.

Eligibility:

- Students must have a 2.5 G.P.A. or higher on their last report card from the spring, in order to apply for the Homecoming Court.
- Students must not have any **F's, N's, or U's** on that spring report card.
- Students must complete all steps of the application on or before the deadline to be eligible to participate in the Homecoming Court

Application:

- The attached application must be completed and turned into room 146 (A.S.B.) during lunch by Wednesday, September 23<sup>rd</sup>. No late applications will be accepted.
- Interviews will be held after school on Tuesday, September 29<sup>th</sup> and Thursday, October 1<sup>st</sup>, in room 146 starting at 3:00 p.m. You must be present for your interview time; no exceptions allowed. You will be given a time slot when you turn in your application. Each interview is scheduled for about 10 minutes.
