### **Mission Statement**

Our mission is to recognize exceptional students of Lincoln High School for their outstanding service to the campus and community, as well as their academic achievements. As part of Lincoln tradition, the Mr. & Miss Lincoln Court represents, promotes, and advance Hornet Pride through philanthropic endeavors while symbolizing commitment and dedication to Lincoln High School.

The Court:

- Mr. & Miss Lincoln Court will consist of no more than 12 individuals. The freshmen, sophomore, and junior class will *each* have one male and one female representative. The senior class will have a maximum of 6 candidates (3 males and 3 females).
- Mr. & Miss Lincoln will be selected from the senior class only and be announced at the Green & White Soirée.

Eligibility:

- Students must have a 2.5 G.P.A. to apply for the Court
- Students must have good attendance and behavior – No F’s, N’s, or U’s on the last grading period.
- Students must complete all steps of the application on or before the deadline to be eligible to participate in the Court.

Application:

- The attached application must be completed and turned into room 146 (A.S.B.) during lunch by Friday, February 13th.
- You must have Mr. Camacho review and approve your application to make sure you are qualified to run. Once you have been officially approved, an information sheet of campaign rules will be given to you to sign. You are not allowed to campaign until your application has been approved and you have signed the campaign rules. Failure to follow these rules will disqualify you from running for the Court.
