Lincoln High School will offer select Summer School courses to expand upon our existing district program. These courses will focus on credit recovery for Lincoln students in the 10th, 11th, and 12th grades.

APEX Mathematics

Period 3/4: 9:45-11:45am, Monday-Friday

Requirements: 9th, 10th, & 11th grade students with a D or F in Algebra, Geometry, or Intermediate Algebra

This course provides students with an opportunity to recover credits in algebra, geometry, and/or intermediate algebra. This will be an online class offered from a classroom at Lincoln. APEX Learning online courses as the curriculum for this course.

APEX English/Social Science

Period 3/4: 9:45-11:45am, Monday-Friday

Requirements: 9th, 10th, & 11th grade students with a D or F in English 1/2, English 3/4, American Literature, World History, and/or US History.

This course provides students with an opportunity to recover credits in English and Social Science courses. This will be an online class offered from a classroom at Lincoln. APEX Learning online courses will be utilized as the curriculum for this course.

APEX Afternoon All Subject Class

Period 5/6: 12:15-2:00 pm, Monday-Friday

Requirements: 9th, 10th, & 11th grade students with a D or F in in a core course.

This course provides students with an opportunity to recover credits in all core courses offered during the regular school year at Lincoln. APEX Learning online courses will be utilized as the curriculum..



Biology 1,2

Period 1/2 & 3/4: 7:25 - 11:45 am, Monday-Friday

Requirements: 10th, 11th, & 12th grade students with a D or F in Biology

This course provides students with an opportunity to recover credits in Biology 1,2. This is a life science class with a lab component.

Chemistry 1,2

Period 1/2 & 3/4: 7:25 - 11:45 am, Monday-Friday

Requirements: 10th, 11th, & 12th grade students with a D or F in Chemistry

This course provides students with an opportunity to recover credits in Chemistry 1,2. This class has a lab component.

Spanish 3,4

Period 1/2 & 3/4: 7:25 - 11:45 am, Monday-Friday

Requirements: 10th, 11th, & 12th grade students

This course provides students with an opportunity to earn a credit in Spanish 3,4.
